



ITALY 2025 ITINERARY







DAY 1 Rome

Saturday, Oct 4

Your epic journey begins with transportation from the airport to the resort. You'll enjoy a guided food tour starting in Campo De' Fiori, continuing through the Jewish Quarter, and ending in Trastevere. Along the way, you'll visit restaurants, bakeries, cafes, and an ancient grocery store, sampling authentic Italian flavors.

DAY 2 Rome Sunday, Oct 5

Experience a guided "Rome's Greatest Hits" tour via the comfort of a golf cart, visiting iconic landmarks like the Colosseum, Spanish Steps, Trevi Fountain, and Circo Massimo. Choose a morning or evening tour, leaving the rest of the day free for personal exploration.

DAY 3 Vatican City Monday, Oct 6

ITALY 2025 INFORMATION

Tour Activity Level: MODERATE

In order to participate in this tour, you must be:

able to walk 1-3 miles over the course of the day, up and down stairs;

comfortable on your feet for up to two hours walking and standing, both inside museums and outdoors in all weather conditions such as hot sun, wind and rain; and able to navigate towns and cities on your own as desired.

Optional Travel Protection

We recommend travelers purchase a Travel Protection Plan, which we offer for your convenience. You assume all responsibility for trip interruption or cancellation if you opt-out of purchasing travel protection/insurance.

A \$500 deposit* per person is required with your registration in order to reserve your spot. Final payment is due to WQPT PBS: June 1, 2025. Tour is recommended for 14 years and up.

DOCUMENTATION Each U.S. citizen must have a valid passport through December 1, 2026, to participate. Holders of non-U.S. passports have different entry requirements. Please note: Due to airline security measures, your passport name must match your airline ticket name and your tour reservation name, or you may be denied aircraft boarding. Effective mid-2025 (expected): All travelers to the Schengen zone of Europe will need to apply for an ETIAS visa waiver.
